ARCHITECTURE

Program Description

The Architecture program was founded in 1967 and is the oldest department at Soegijapranata Catholic University (originally part of Atma Jaya Catholic University Semarang). Currently there are more than 2100 alumnae holding strategic positions in bureaucratic administration, large businesses, higher education institutions as well as related professional associations.

As part of society, the Architecture program develops a pattern of scientific principles in eco-architecture which focuses attention on harmony and balance of life, the macro and micro cosmos, between human and the natural, through the creation of buildings and the built environment as a medium.

Curriculum

The Architecture curriculum consists of 149 credits that can be completed in 8 semesters. However, the course is designed to be completed in 3.5 years (7 semesters) or less; allowing graduates more time to work productively toward their goals and dreams for the future.

Teaching Staff

Lecturers possess masters or doctoral degrees with further certifications from related professional organizations. Their expertise and knowledge in business, science and technology assist graduates to achieve their future goals in architecture and built environment.

Facilities

The availability of studio facilities, laboratories, and workshops allows the students to learn the materials in an easier and more enjoyable way.



Key Competence

Graduates are able to:

- propose and develop creative ideas in the field of architecture (buildings, environment, housing, and urban)
- implement and develop image management with an approach that is of an international standard
- understand and apply architectural problem-solving ideas in creative architectural design.

- Graduates are able to operationalize and implement program (software) design as the basis for the development of architectural design.
- Graduates are able to communicate and utilize information technology media that operates in English.
- Graduates are able to work together in design workshop groups.
- Graduates are honest and appreciative of the time and professionalism required.
- Graduates have leadership and entrepreneurship skills.

Career Opportunities

Mostly the alumnae of the program could find employment in less than 3 months. Some graduates are able to obtain employment work independently or become professional interns with senior architects.

The Architecture program supports the lifelong learning of its alumnae with ongoing activities such as conducting seminars and training on new science and technology as well as business skills development. These activities often involve experts, professionals and highly motivational lecturers both from within and outside the campus environment.
